Inaugural Address

Registrar of Mother Teresa Women's University Dr.A.Suganthi proposed the inaugural address. She gave a brief account of the patent rights that India has missed in the past like Patent rights for neem and turmeric and what struggle it had to cancel them. She also addressed the importance of inventions to be patented. She encouraged young researchers and faculty members to patent their innovative works.



Special Address

Special Address was delivered by the special guest of the event Mr.A.Raja, Assistant Controller of Patents and Designs, Patent Office Chennai. He gave a brief introduction on Intellectual Property Rights and their types. He mentioned a few important amendments and guidelines that we have to remember and take into consideration before applying for patents. He encouraged woman scientists and students to apply for more patents and copyrights and discussed in detail about the discounts in applying fees that are available for woman candidates. He also shared a few thoughts on the legal status of Intellectual Property Rights.



Release of IP policy of MTWU

In TamilNadu IP Cells have been formed in almost 8 Universities. Mother Teresa Women's University is now proud to be one among them and also the IP policy was framed and released by the dignitaries of the event on the Dias.

This successful Inaugural function of the IP Cell and One Day Awareness Programme on “Intellectual Property Rights” was concluded with a Vote of Thanks delivered by Mr.Mithilesh Kumar, Joint Secretary, PHD Chamber, Delhi

Technical Session I

First technical session on Intellectual Property definition, concept, identification and creation was handled by Mr.Sandeep Agarwal, Director from Adastra IP. He gave a brief introduction to Intellectual Property Rights and its importance. He introduced concepts such as Patents, Copy rights, Designs, Trademarks and other concepts of IPR to the audience. He emphasized the need of patenting and other intellectual property rights of an invention before

publication. He also gave an overview of concepts in IPR such as Service Marks, Geographical Indicators, Plant Varieties, Semi-conductor Integrated circuits lay out design.



Technical Session II

The next session was delivered by Dr, Mandira Roy, Director-commercialisation and tech transfer, Director, Adastra IP. She discussed in detail about the procedures for registering our intellectual property. She highlighted on topics such as patents, designs and trademarks. A brief detail on what can be patented, what documents are required and the detailed procedure for submitting applications in the patent office was discussed by Dr.Mandira Roy.



Technical Session III

Patent Informatics details were provided in the next session by Mr.SandeepAgarwal. He explained in detail about the rights of the IP right holder against infringement. He also addressed the audience on the challenges faced by institutions such as Universities in managing its IP assets. Remedies to act against infringement were also said to audience.

Technical Session IV

Information on commercialisation of Patents was given in the Fourth technical session of the awareness programme by Dr.Mandira Roy. She quoted examples of successful patents that were commercialized and gained lots of income. She explained to the audience the need of novelty in an invention. She told the importance of filling a patent before publication of an invention and the steps involved in filling Intellectual Property and the nominal fees of the procedures.

Technical Session V

A lecture on the formalities, ease and time span required for filling patent and processing it was presented to the gathering by SandeepAgarwal. The protocols of obtaining patents and copy rights in India were explained in detail. A gist of the legal frame work in India and other related concepts were also discussed.

Technical Session VI

The final session was addressed by Er. T. Sahila, Project Scientist, Patent InformationCentre, Tamilnadu State Council for Science and Technology, Chennai. Mam gave a brief idea about the support that will be rendered to the University from Patent information centre. She also explained about the processes that will be required by individual candidates to file Intellectual property.

Technical speakers from Aadastra IP and TNSCST cleared the doubts of the participants regarding Intellectual Property Rights and encouraged woman researches to put more effort into inventions that can be patented.

Dr.A. Usha Raja Nanthini, IP cell coordinator delivered the Vote of thanks. Presidential Address

Presidential address was delivered by our honourable Vice Chancellor of Mother Teresa Women's University, Dr.G.Valli. She welcomed the garlic cultivars to the awareness program. In detail, the importance of Geographical indication was addressed to the cultivars. She also explained to the farmers, how their economic status would improve through the GI obtained for Kodaikanal Garlic (Kodaikanal malaipoondu).



Awareness on GI

Dr. A. Usha Raja Nanthini, Co-ordinator of the Intellectual Property Cell, Mother Teresa Women's University inculcated the awareness in the native cultivars on obtaining GI for Kodaikanal malaipoondu. She introduced the logo for Kodaikanal malaipoondu to the audience that has been applied for GI. She also presented in detail the process that was undergone to apply for GI to Kodaikanal malaipoondu. The help rendered by TNSCST, Er. Shakila, native garlic cultivars for gathering details required for GI submission was highlighted with gratitude.

The Co-ordinator briefed the evidences and proofs submitted for Kodaikanal malaipoondu GI. She also insisted the necessity of cultivars association with a proper hierarchical administration. Since this will completely help the farmers in improving their lifestyles after obtaining the GI. The farmers can fix the price for themselves instead of depending on markets such as the Vadugapatti market. She also explained to the cultivars that obtaining a GI for Garlic can increase the popularity of the product in the market worldwide. This can help the farmers to sell their garlic from the cultivation site for a better price.



Er. T. Shahila explained what exactly is Geographical Indication? and which all products have received the status of GI and what sort of benefits were obtained by GI to those product producers.



Open floor

In this session the garlic cultivars clarified their doubts regarding the GI for Kodaikanal malaipoondu. Cultivars raised questions on the need and importance for GI, cleared doubts on selling the garlic after obtaining GI, how the information of the GI obtained will reach the people in and out of the state? How a GI can change the economic status of the farmer etc.,

The honourable Vice Chancellor of Mother Teresa Women's University, Dr. G. Valli and the IP Cell Co-ordinator Dr.A. Usha Raja Nanthini, with immense patience explained and clarified the doubts and questions posed by the Garlic cultivars. They also explained how the media and the logo would help people recognize Kodaikanal garlic form other garlic varieties. They once again insisted to the Garlic cultivars to form an association consisting of members from various places with a head. They clarified all the doubts and also emphasized that supplying Kodaikanal garlic without any adulteration and with the logo of GI would fetch them the right price for their garlic.





While the Programme was going on Thasildar and Chairman for Kodaikanal joined the Dias as appreciated the efforts of Mother Teresa Women's University. They also address the farmers by briefing the importance of GI. Dr. A. Usha Raja Nanthini delivered vote of Thanks.

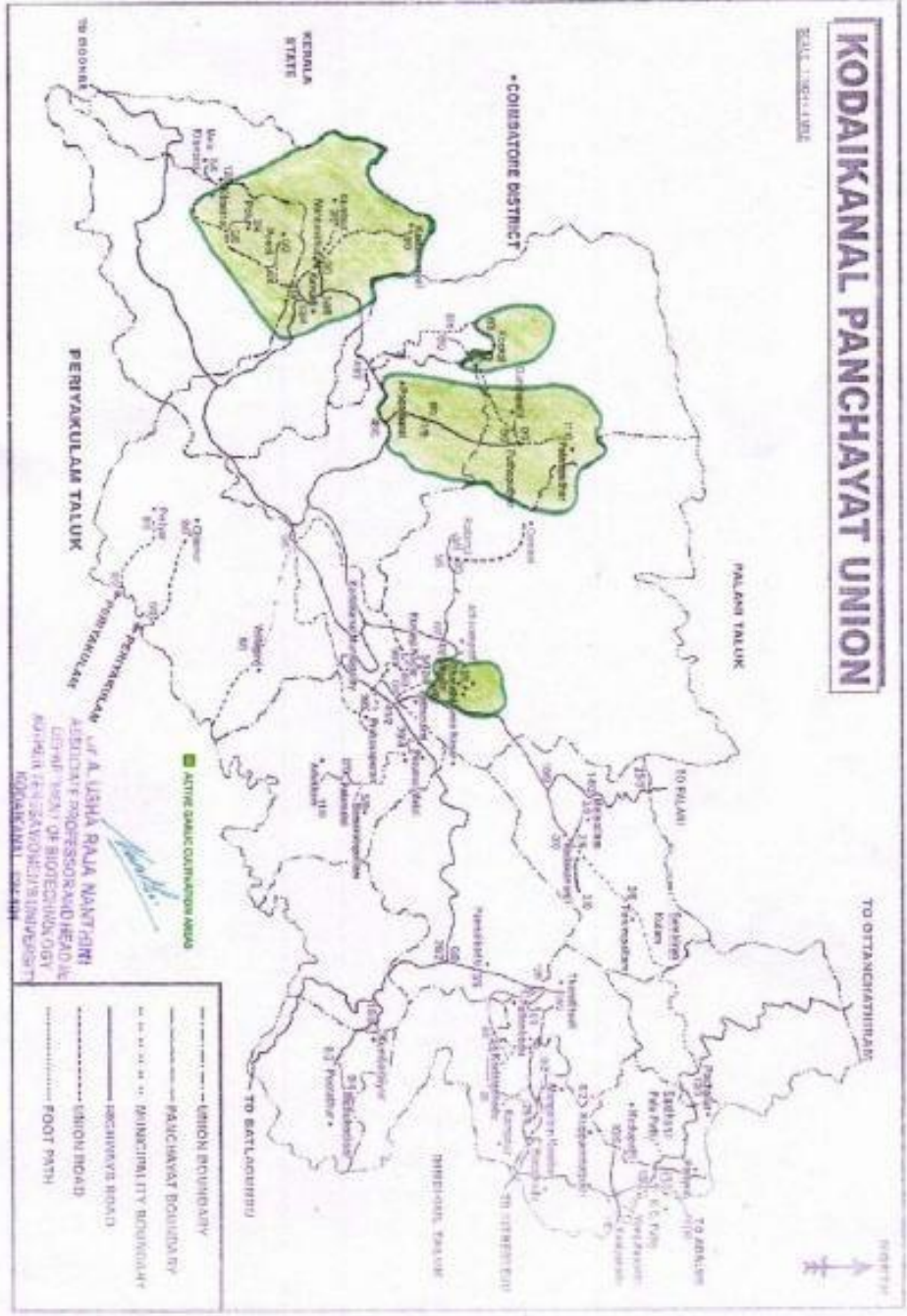
