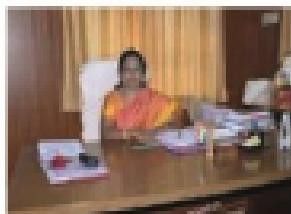
Greetings and best wishes!
