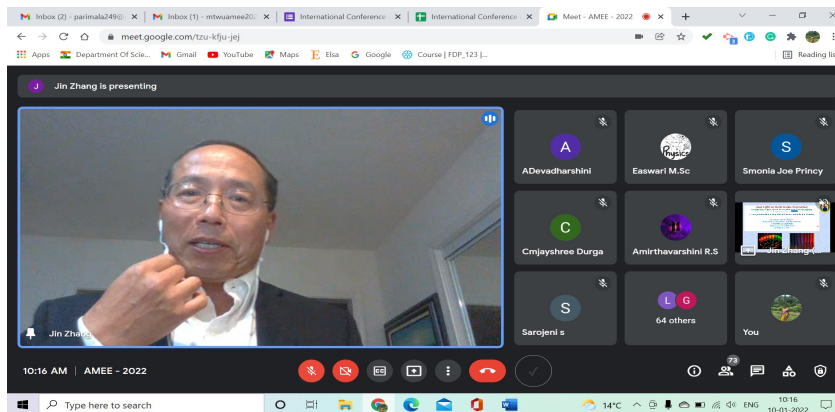

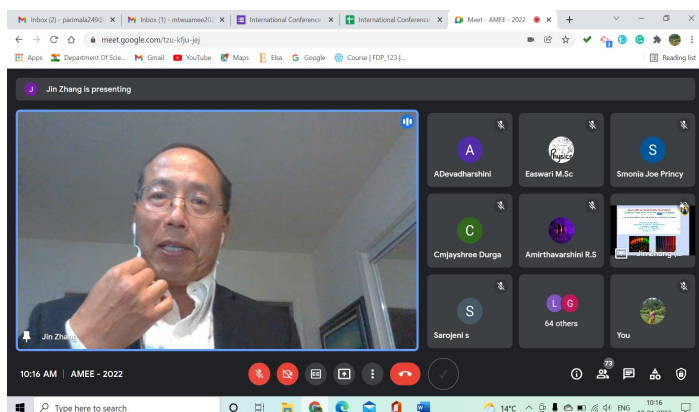

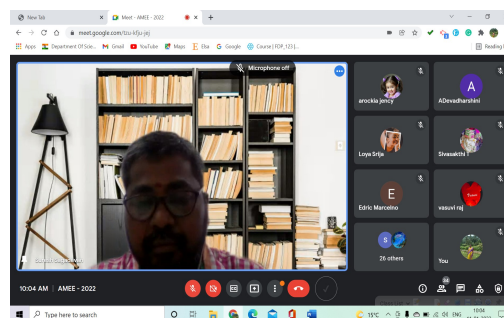
Keynote Address by Prof. Jin Zhong Zhang,

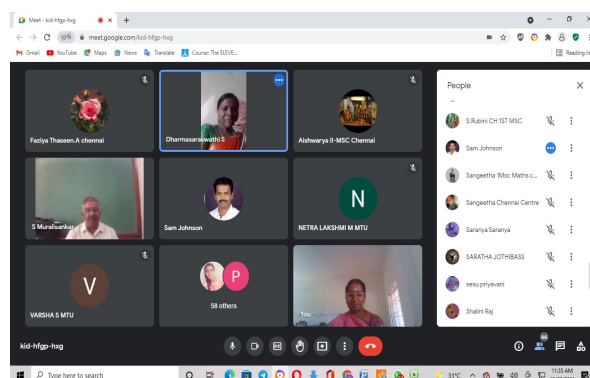
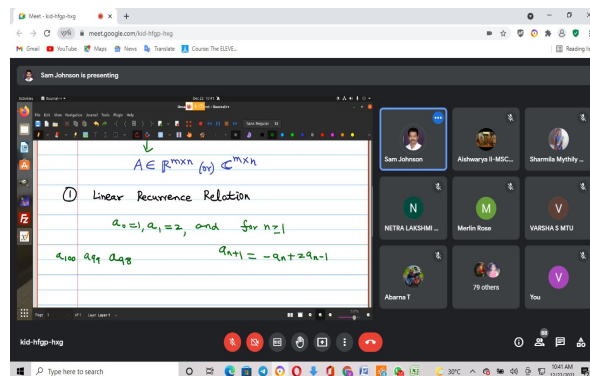
Organized one day National Workshop on Analysis and its Application on 22.12.2021 through online mode.

Person solved many problems such as analytic geometry, Pin-Hole number, natural sciences problem, computation problem, recursion, inverse in economics and few more non-repeated.

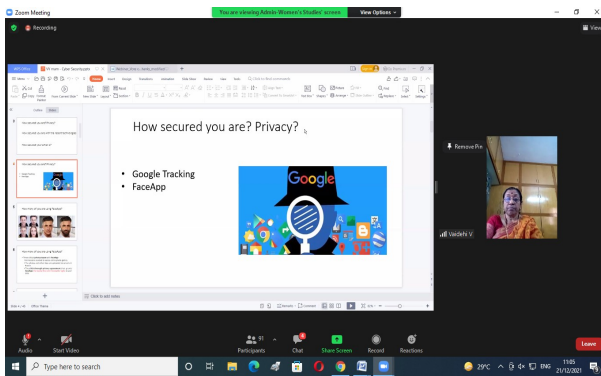

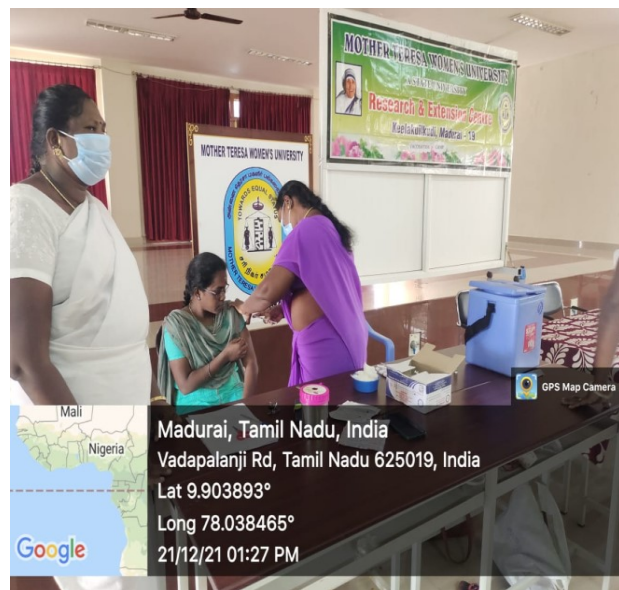

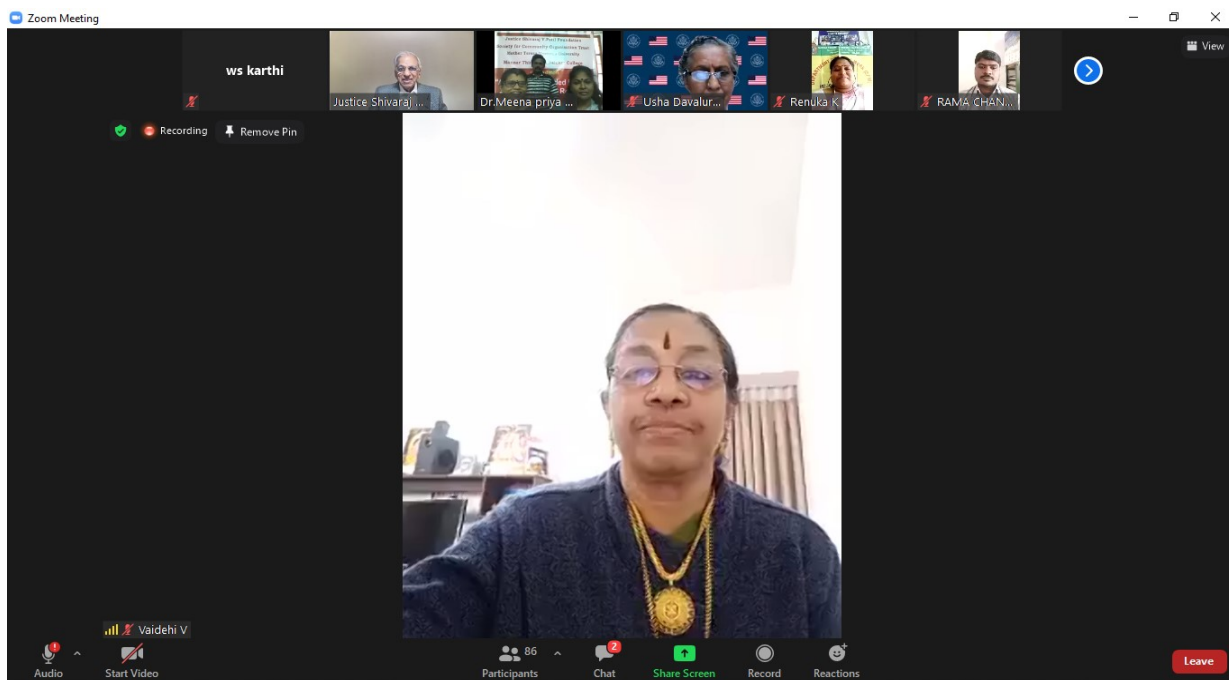

### Webinar on “Abolition of Bonded Labour System: Myth or Reality” on 9<sup>th</sup> Feb2022

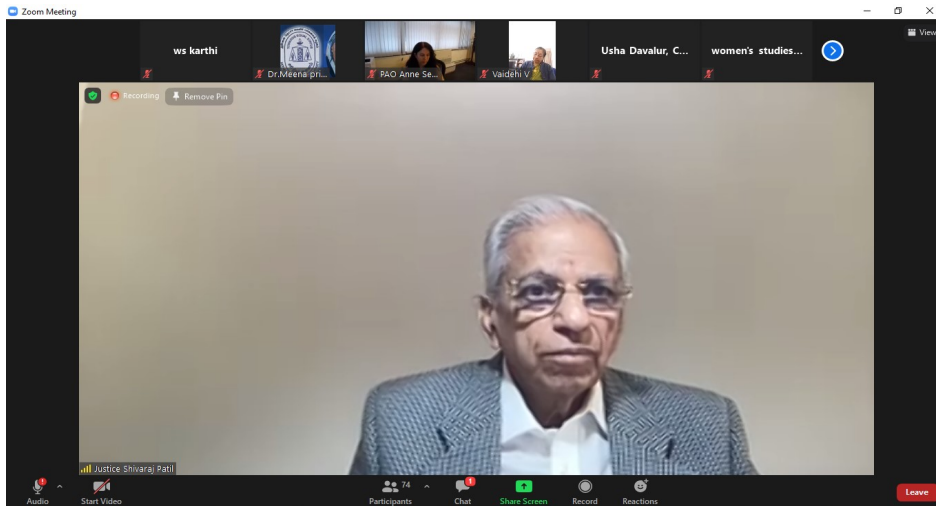

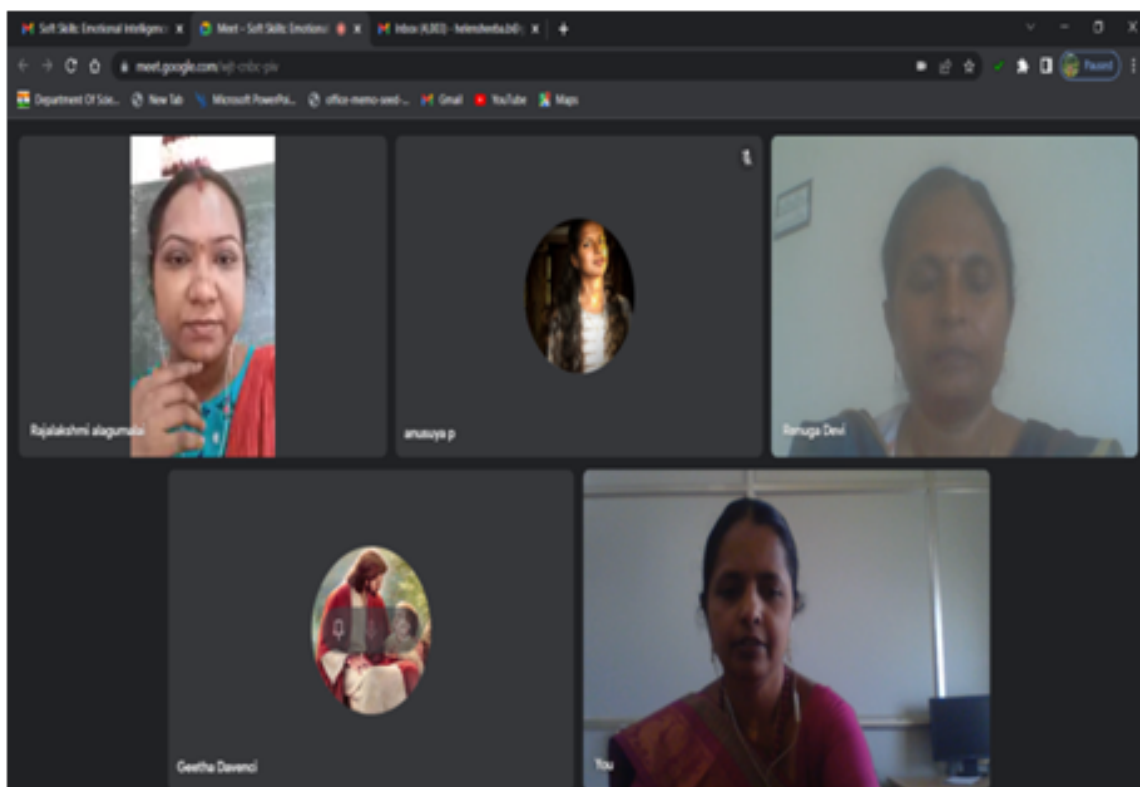


## World Cancer Day

Preethi of II M.A English proposed vote of thanks for this session. It is held offline and online. Nearly 80 students from English department participated.

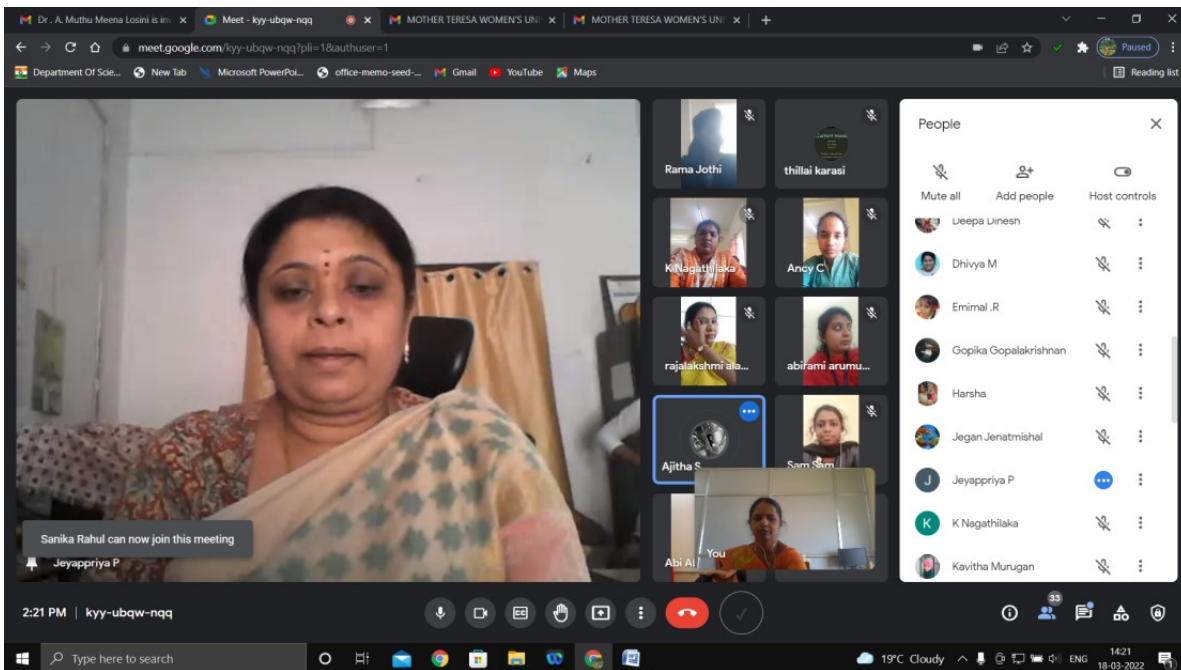
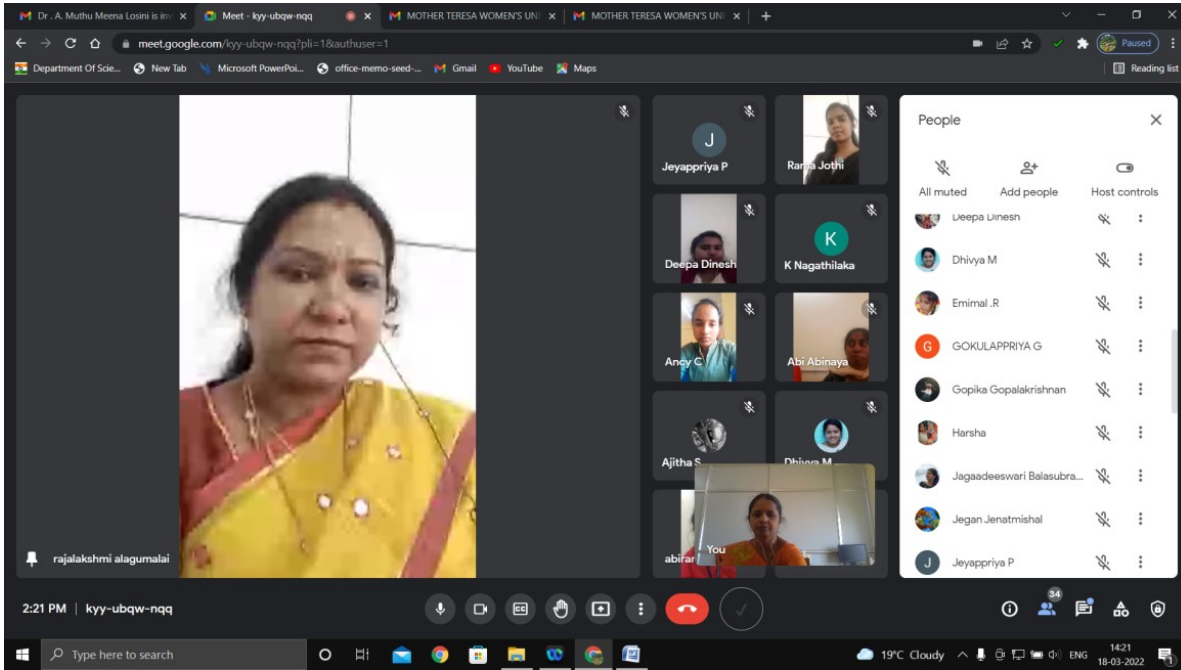


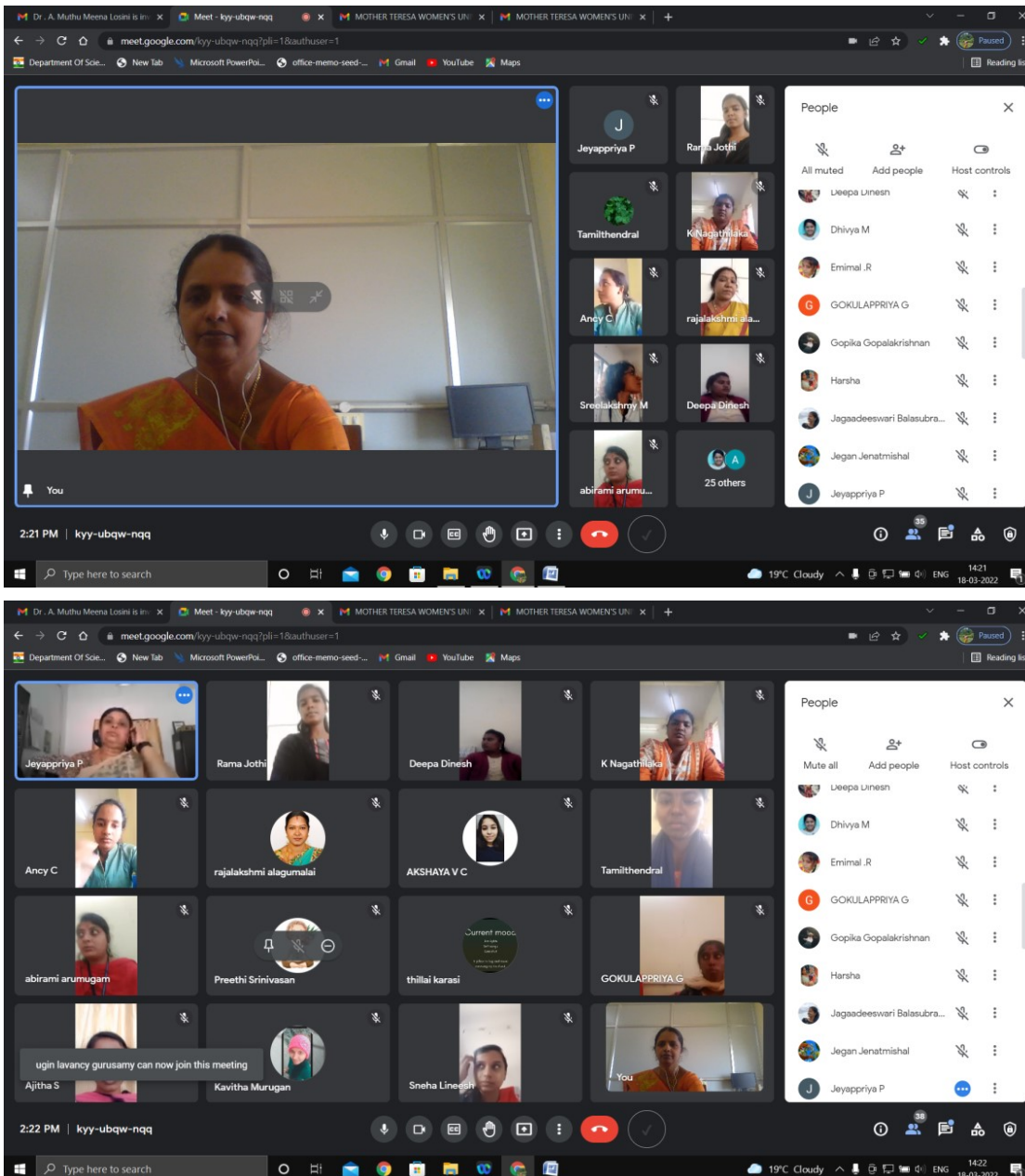
### **Commemoration of Subhash Chandra Bose Birthday**

He highlighted that most of the plants contain glycosides, alkaloids, terpenoids, flavonoids, carotenoids, etc., that are frequently implicated as having antidiabetic effect. The successful treatment and management of diabetes are yet to be discovered. He stated that within the Indian subcontinent, extensive research has been performed in the ethno-medicine system to find out the possible uses of the plant as anti-diabetic agents. Therefore, in order to use the biological compound from plant resources, additional steps are required such as pharmacological
