Measures taken to complete the syllabus of courses and programs.	<p>The University has devised a semester-wise action plan for providing online education to the students without lacuna and ensures its implementation through the University's Learning Management System.</p> <p>The University has provided training to faculties to adopt a pedagogical shift from the traditional method of teaching to a digital mode of teaching using digital platforms. The faculties could organize online classes via Google Meet using their Institutional Mail IDs. Besides Google Meet, other online educational platforms such as ZOOM and Cisco Webex have been utilized effectively for syllabus coverage. The University also has ensured 24*7 internet supply for the uninterrupted online educational service. Class timetables scheduled from 10.00 a.m. to 04.30 p.m. are strictly adhered to by all the faculties under the mentorship of the respective HoDs. Class links are shared in their Teacher-Students Whatsapp groups every day. Special classes have been conducted from 04.30 p.m. to 05.30 p.m. every day by the faculties for syllabus coverage and for providing special coaching for slow learners. Saturday classes have been conducted as per the government of Tamil Nadu's guidelines. Attendance has been recorded regularly. By adopting Flipped Learning Method students have been actively engaged in online education. Besides the regular classes, online National / International seminars, conferences, invited lectures and workshops have been organized for enhancing the learners' knowledge and skills.</p> <p>All the online classes have been monitored by the heads of the departments. Weekly / Monthly screenshots of the online classes have been collected and submitted to the University authorities which are duly recorded as evidence.</p> <p>The University's Learning Management System functions effectively for continuous monitoring of the online teaching-learning process. Self-Learning-Materials, PPTs and Video lectures prepared by the faculties with the help of the University Media Centre have been posted on the University Website, Google Classrooms, and Moodle.</p> <p>Three Internal tests have been conducted as chronicled in MTWU Academic Calendar. Continuous Internal Assessments have been made for the individual students through online quizzes, seminars, assignments, and evaluation of the test scripts. Question papers have been set on the model of Bloom's Taxonomy. The Internal assessments and students' attendance percentage are uploaded in the University web portal which could be viewed by the students through the Students' Login.</p> <p>Online examinations have been conducted without lacuna. As per the guidelines of the State, November 2021 Examinations have been conducted; question papers have been designed to suit the online examination to test the learning levels of the students. Softcopies of the answer scripts are uploaded in the Exam Portal within an hour of the examination and the hard copies are received through post/courier/in-person. Results have been published on the University Website within ten days of the examinations.</p> <p>Students' satisfaction survey has been made through University's web portal and the consolidated reports have been sent to the respective faculty for betterment.</p>
