2. Measures taken to complete the syllabus of courses and programs.	<p>All courses in PG programmes shall carry a Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA) and End Semester examinations. It will be conducted for Evaluating/ grading the student performance in each paper/ course to know the coverage of syllabus. Academic calendar includes a schedule of Internal Assessment tests per semester and End Semester examinations which will be circulated to all the Department/Faculty/Students/ Centre/ Concerned Section regularly. Continuous Internal assessment shall be done by the faculty member responsible for the courses. The internal assessment of different forms including periodic class test as objective/ essay/ viva-voce; quiz type; class/ home assignment; class seminar; group discussion etc. per course in addition to the examination at the end of each semester. The tests shall be spread throughout the semester before the commencement of End semester examination. Pass mark (50%) should be obtained from both CIA and end semester examination. It is mandatory for all students to participate in all the Internal Assessment tests and in various course-work related activities for the award of the marks. The result of the continuous assessment of the students used to be communicated to students immediately after the assessment. It enabled them to perform better in the ensuing internals and externals. A record of such assessment procedure will be maintained by the Department and shall be used for clarification by the students. Students will have the right to appeal to the Head of the Department/ Dean in case of glaring disparities in marking. The final result in each semester shall calculated on the basis of this continuous assessment and performance in the end semester examination. The assessment will be coordinated with all the Departments by Dean. An End Semester examination shall be conducted by the Controller of Examination.</p>
