CODE OF ETHICS POLICY

The Code of Ethics Policy of Mother Teresa Women's University has been framed in order to realize the University's vision of women empowerment in strict compliance with ethical integrity and moral values.

The Code of Ethics of the University shall be called "Mother Teresa Women's University's Code of Ethics and Conduct Rules." It encompasses students, teachers, and administrative staff. It governs the fundamental rules of ethical conduct that are applicable to all members of the University.

MTWU's Code of Ethics and Conduct Rules includes the "Fundamental Rules of the Tamil Nadu Government" that are applicable to the employees of all Tamil Nadu State Government Institutions. The University's Code of Ethics and Conduct Rules prescribed in the Statutes shall be amended as per the Government of Tamil Nadu's norms.

Internal Monitoring Committees for Students, Teaching, and Non-Teaching Staff have been constituted for monitoring their adherence to the University's Code of Ethics and Conduct Rules in all their academic and administrative activities.

The students, teaching and non-teaching faculty are strictly instructed and expected to abide by the code of ethics and conduct rules, dispose their duties and facilitate the effective functioning of the University.
