POLICY FOR THE CREATION OF DISABLED FRIENDLY AND BARRIER FREE ENVIRONMENT

Mother Teresa Women's University's Policy for the creation of Disabled Friendly and Barrier free Environment, has been framed as per the guidelines of the Ministry of Urban Development Government of India, for the Empowerment of persons with disabilities, UGC norms, and "Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full Participation) Act, 1995 enacted by the Government of India on January 1, 1996.

As per the Mother Teresa Women's University Disabled Friendly and Barrier Free Environment Policy, a barrier free environment will be created in the University premises with provisions for ramps in buildings, adaptation of toilets for wheel chair users, Braille symbols in signage posts for enabling the physically challenged people to have hassle free, safe mobility and utilization of the University resources in and around the University campus.

An internal committee consisting of the Vice Chancellor as the Chair Person, a Nodal Officer, a faculty, a student, and a parent representative shall monitor the establishment and effective utilization of the special infrastructure by the students with disabilities.
